

فراخوان اقتصاددانان جهان در رابطه با یونان

ما امضاء کنندگان، حکومت های اروپا، کمیسیون اروپا، بانک مرکزی اروپا و صندوق بین المللی پول را فرا می خوانیم، به تصمیم مردم یونان مبنی بر انتخاب مسیری نو احترام بگذارند و با حسن نیت در مذاکرات با حکومت جدید یونان جهت حل معضل بدھی های این کشور، شرکت کنند.

حکومت یونان به حق بر راهکارهای جدید اصرار می ورزد، چرا که برنامه های تا کنون شکست خورده اند. این برنامه ها منجر به بهبود اقتصادی و ثبات مالی نشدند. آنها جامعه یونان را تحت فشار قرار داده و نهاد های آنرا تضعیف کردند. این نحوه عمل نا مناسب است و دارای هیچ پیشرفتی نبوده که ارزش حفظ کردن داشته باشد. ما عاجلانه از شرکای یونان تقاضا داریم، این واقعیت را بپذیرند. چرا که بدون آن این حکومت جدید هرگز انتخاب نمی شد.

یونان به کمک انساندوستانه فوری نیاز دارد، حداقل دستمزد بالاتر، اشتغال بیشتر، سرمایه گذاری و اقدامات لازم جهت تجدید فراوری و بهبود خدمات اساسی مانند آموزش و پرورش و بهداشت. این کشور به یک نظام مالیاتی کارآتر و پیشرفته تر نیاز دارد، که کمتر بر مالیات ارزش افزوده متکی باشد و موثرتر بر اساس مالیات بر درآمد و ثروت عمل کند. فساد باید با مبارزه و مجازات ریشه کن شود. از نظر سیاست مالی حکومت جدید باید امکان حرکت داشته باشد، تا بتواند این اقدامات را به ثمر برساند و درستی آنها را نشان دهد. حمایت مستمر مالی بانک مرکزی اروپا ضروری است، تا در این فاصله بخش مالی پایدار بماند. ما از شرکای اروپائی یونان و نهاد های دیگر عاجلاً تقاضا می کنیم، این امکان حرکت و حمایت را ممکن سازند.

حکومت یونان به حق خواهان معافیت از بدھی ها یش به شرکای اروپائی خود است. این بدھی ها غیر واقعی هستند و از این رو به هر حال به طور کامل باز پرداخت نخواهند شد. بنا بر این با معافیت از بدھی ها زیان اقتصادی به بار نخواهد آمد، نه برای کشورهای دیگر و نه برای مالیات دهنده‌گان. کاملاً بر عکس، یک آغاز نو در یونان برای شرکای او

هم امکان فعالیت های جدید، در آمد و سود فراهم خواهد کرد. ما از بستانکاران یونان تقاضا داریم این فرصت را جدی بگیرند و این واقعیت را برای مردم کشور خود به روشنی و صادقانه توضیح دهند.

این همه به آینده اروپا نیز مربوط است. سیاست تهدید و هراس افکنی، سیاست ضرب العجل، لجاجت و باج خواهی، تنها به اروپائی ها نشان خواهد داد که پروره اروپا شکست خورده است. در اینصورت شکستی اخلاقی، سیاسی و اقتصادی خواهد بود. ما از رهبران اروپا درخواست می کنیم از هر گونه اجباری بر حکومت و مردم یونان خودداری کرده و آنرا محکوم کنند.

موفقیت یونان می تواند بدون شک راه رفاه و ثبات نو را نشان دهد و با نقش تازه ای برای دموکراسی و فضای باز انتخاباتی، منجر به تغییرات سازنده گردد. ما با یونان و اروپا مشترکا از دموکراسی و تغیر دفاع می کنیم.

ما از سیاستمداران اصلی اروپا تقاضا داریم به پروسه تصمیم گیری یونانی ها که نتیجه مبارزه ای دشوار و انتخابی دموکراتیک است، احترام بگذارند و راه یک ارزیابی واقعیتناه و مذاکرات نتیجه بخش را در پیش گیرند.
